#### Comments on Alta Planning draft document

- Page 50 Add clarification to funding and an example maybe in a sidebar.
- Couch this as an investment, will help economic development and business, identify the benefit. Put in executive summary and elaborate more on page 50.
- No comments or changes in Chapters 1-3.
- Concerns about lack of equestrian in Chapter 4. State Parks does most of these trails and they have equestrian representatives on their council. This should alleviate that concern, however BRAVO will try to think of ways to strengthen this.
- No comment Chapter 5.
- In Recommendations, SP4 – Take out Johnny Behind the Rocks near Lander – this is not a state asset.
- Add a picture to page 74.
- NPS6, This could create a conflict between user groups, maybe soften and suggest they explore more opportunities and look at success stories from other agencies.

#### Public Comment

Liz Storer – Is the 10M on page 50 new funds, then leveraged with private or federal funds? It is challenging at the agency level if they have to reroute funds. Might be more understandable to spell out.

Liz Storer – First page make a vision statement, Why did you do all this work, what is the value? Draws in the reader with a more narrative fashion. Clear document, but dry. Additions would say this is why we did this. She offered to help with this.
