Basic Purpose:

The Broadband Manager coordinates statewide efforts to promote, increase and improve broadband service across the state. The Manager will gather and evaluate common goals, develop policy recommendations, implement plans and act as a liaison between WBC, the Broadband Advisory Council, industry representatives and ENDOW. Drives results, engages others to implement opportunities and deploys resources to align with strategic priorities.

Essential skills:

- Established leadership experience in telecommunications, specifically the broadband industry.
- Must be highly skilled in collaboration: bringing multiple viewpoints together to accomplish a single vision, encouraging discussion and establishing win-win solutions.
- Skilled at identifying trends and emerging needs.
- Knowledge of applicable laws, rules, regulations and policies governing telecommunications, the broadband industry, and public finance.

More specifically, the successful applicant will:

- Serve as a liaison between WBC, Broadband Advisory Council, industry representatives and ENDOW.
- Develop and nurture local public-private partnerships to promote broadband service and access.
- Develop a broadband grant program and funding recommendations.
- Build broadband policy recommendations in collaboration with related parties.
- Act as a resource to communities to secure federal funding.
- Engage a variety of public and private interests to create, maintain, and update a broadband enhancement plan that establishes common goals and actionable results toward broadband expansion.
