COMMUNITY READINESS

Applicant: City of Lander

Project Name: Table Mountain Living Community Infrastructure Project Project Details: The City of Lander requests an \$889,105 BRC Community Readiness grant to place infrastructure for the accommodation of the city-owned Table Mountain Living Community. The infrastructure will include water, sewer, communications, power, natural gas, and improved street access. Once the infrastructure is in place, the site will then house a new 36-bed (22-bed assisted living/14-bed memory care) healthcare facility that will be city-owned and operated.

PLANNING

Applicant: City of Newcastle Project Name: Heritage Park Feasibility Study

Project Details: The City of Newcastle requests a \$25,000 BRC Planning grant to research and plan for the proposed Heritage Park project. The potential Heritage Park project would be the development of a new area to encourage community gatherings and a home for a Veteran's Memorial.

Applicant: City of Rawlins

Project Name: Economic Development Plan

Project Details: The City of Rawlins requests a \$37,500 BRC planning grant to develop a 5-year economic plan that will outline the economic vision, mission and goals of the community, as well as strategies for implementation.

Applicant: Sheridan Economic and Educational Development Authority (SEEDA) Project Name: Sheridan High-Tech Park Phase II Feasibility Assessment Project Details: SEEDA requests a \$20,000 BRC planning grant to evaluate three to four potential sites for a continuation of the High-Tech Park concept.
